GB VETS STRIKE GOLD IN BIRMINGH

The 11th World Masters took place in glorious sunshine in Birmingham between 20th - 27th July 2012.

Over 750 competitors from 47 Nations took part, of which no less than 73 were members of the GB Vets Club.

The venues - Edgbaston Priory Club and University of Birmingham mainly - were excellent whilst the organisation was outstanding.

President Phil Ayton says: 'One downside

was that the tournament was played under PARS to 11 scoring. Separate from being fundamentally against our ideals, this had the shocking effect of reducing matches to ridiculously short contests. For us Vets Club members, this was disappointing, but for our overseas visitors it must have been galling'.

Early in the tournament the GB Vets hosted an evening reception/ drinks party organised by our President. A thoroughly enjoyable and

In brief, this year's tournament finals returned again to Broxbourne and were held over the weekend of 2lst/22nd April.

Some 60 matches were played producing many high quality, exciting battles.

We had a new age group for the first time – O80 – won by Alex Hamilton who had travelled 900 miles, had two close 5 setters and overcame Jim Switzer in the final. Averil Murphy has very kindly agreed to present a Cup/Trophy for this event which should be available for our Anniversary finals in April 2013.

Our thanks as always to our hosts, Broxbourne Squash Club, for letting us disrupt their member's weekend and especially to Karen Lane for helping organise the weekend. Also thanks to Jane Belle and Terry Woodliffe for assisting with registration, recording results and sorting the trophies.

The AGM produced some lively debate on the PARS vs HiHo topic with the majority of members in favour of keeping traditional scoring.

Martin Pearse, Chairman of England Squash Masters Committee, proposed that the Tournament be played over a single weekend with the doubles and singles being separate weekends and venues. This was also met with approval from the floor. More details regarding this topic can be found later in this Newsletter.



NEW ACCOUNTING PERIOD AND ACCOUNTS TO YEAR END 30th JUNE 2012

At the AGM last April it was pointed out from the floor that the accounts being presented for approval were always some ten months old (being drawn up to 30th June). It was suggested that a change of date might enable the meeting to see a more up to date position. The Committee agreed that the suggestion had merit and

that it would be discussed at their next meeting. At the Committee meeting in May the matter was debated and it was agreed that the accounting date would be changed to December 3lst.

These accounts to 30th June are therefore now published as an interim measure. The Hon. Treasurer will draw up accounts for the 18-month period to 31st December 2012, and these will be presented for approval at the AGM next April. Subsequent accounts will be drawn up for the 12-month period to 31st December each year.

NORTH WEST OPEN MASTERS TOURNAMENT

GROVE PARK, STOCKPORT, CHESHIRE — 31 AUG-2 SEPT

New member, Paul Vale, organised the above event – a 'first' for the North West – an inaugural Regional Masters Tournament to mirror the other 5 Regionals.

With over 100 entrants the aim was to promote squash to be included in the 2020 Olympic Games as well as to become a 'sanctioned points ranking event' in future years.

Clearly a successful event this year – next year's event is already planned for 6-8 September.

Unfortunately not many GB Vets featured in the medals but congratulations to local lad Rod Boswell for winning the Men's O65, Adrian Wright for winning the O70 and Jane Law who beat Bett Dryhurst in the women's O50.
