# SUMMER 2014 NEWSLETTER NEW CHAIRMAN NEW SEASONS MESSAGE

Following the retirement of John Woodliffe after 20 years sterling service to our Club and squash in general, Tom Hendry has very kindly agreed to be a caretaker Chairman for the next few years.

Tom is no stranger to squash, having played at the very top in his 'youth' or the Club having been Hon. Secretary for 13 years.

Below is an extract from his first message as Chairman – which can be seen in full on the website:

I was honoured and delighted to be elected as your new Chairman at the well attended AGM at Colets on April 6th following another very successful Club Finals Weekend. I have been able to serve the GB Vets Club in various ways since taking over from the dearly remembered John Timperley as Hon Secretary in 1992. To become your Chairman following the retirement of John Woodliffe after his twenty years' service is at once a challenge and a privilege.

We were all pleased to acclaim John's magnificent contribution to our Club with a special presentation.

In our 50th Anniversary Book 50 Years On, John most appropriately provided



the final article Looking Forward-The Future of the Vets Club of GB. In a paragraph on the Club's strengths John highlighted friendly Inter-Club Matches, Tours, the Annual Club Tournament and Doubles. I am pleased to report that, at the first Committee meeting under my chairmanship in June, which was also attended by our President, it was agreed that we should drive the Club's ambitions forward in these areas. All members took upon a task- led by Match Manager David Smith- to organize at least two new friendly fixtures each during the 2014-15 season. Some of these may be the revival of previous events, others may be new.

With regards to Tours, although we recognized the increased cost of longdistance overseas Tours, we plan to investigate the viability of nearer Tours and, perhaps, of inviting overseas teams to tour Great Britain with the help and support of our Club.

We also considered a number of other ideas including the opportunity to sponsor a Midlands/Northern based Festival of Squash, the relaunch of the Veterans' Doubles under the auspices of the GB Vets and the expansion of the range of events in our Annual Club Tournament to provide separate events for "non- elite" players. I agreed to talk with both England Squash and England Squash Masters to discuss these initiatives.

I do believe that this combination of reviving previously successful events and pursuing some new initiatives will reinvigorate the appeal of our Club for our current and future members whilst preserving our objectives and our fundamental values.


### PAID UP YET?

# **THE CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS 2014**

The finals were held over the weekend 5/6th April 2014 at Colets, Thames Ditton with 63 matches played in 16 different events.

Highlights of Saturday were a tight game between England O'65 players Barry Featherstone and Aubrey Waddy and the O'45 Doubles between Stuart Hardy and Dermot Hurford against last year's winners Chris Ansell and Graham Hooper,

Barry winning the singles and Stuart and Dermot the doubles.

The Ladies O'50 was played as a round robin on Saturday with Mandy Akin and Claire Baker coming out on top in each division. In Sunday's finals England No1 Mandy proved too strong for Claire and Lynne Davies won the Plate Final over newcomer to the club, Julia Ledger.

With only two entries in the Ladies O'40 the final was between Sam Mueller and Alison Goy with England Captain, Sam, winning 3-1.

The Ladies Doubles Final was a repeat of last year but with the opposite result – Mandy and Karen beating Tammy Bennett and Kim Ricks.

On Sunday the men's tournament provided some good squash. Mark Hildred drove from Boston in the morning to beat Nick Dart in the O'45 final. Darren Withey was pushed by Ian Mann in the O'50 Semi before Darren won 3-1 and then went on to beat Dermot Hurford 3-0 in the final. Stuart Hardy retained his O'55 title, as did Steve Jackson in the O'60, Philip Ayton O'65 John Woodliffe O'75 and Wilf Mann in the O'80. Brian Phillips won the O'70 singles and with George Aplin the same age doubles.

Doubles on a singles court played by top players can be a frantic affair. I'm pleased to say that no-one was injured in any of our matches. Darren Withey and Chris Harland coming out top in the O'45 event, Syd Spittle and Carlos Marques O'55, Geoff Howes and Aubrey Waddy moving into their correct age bracket the O'65, and not surprisingly John Woodliffe and Lance Kinder in the hastily arranged O'75.

The AGM followed the finals with a presentation to the retiring John Woodliffe, thanking him for his 20 years of service as Chairman and the election of Tom Hendry as a "Temporary" replacement.

The Cups, Salvers, Trophies and glassware were then presented to the winners and runners-up. The Burrell Trophy was awarded to David Garrett and the newly donated Norman Hunt Trophy "For a member considered to have made a special contribution to the spirit of the tournament" was awarded to our top referee Dean Clayton.

My thanks must go to Dean for marking almost non-stop over the weekend and to all those others who helped with this task. To Jane Belle for manning (ladying doesn't sound right) the desk and recording the results all weekend. Also to Terry Woodliffe and Christine Howes for their assistance on Sunday and to Colets for hosting the whole event.

Finally to the supporters and all players whose attitude and good humour makes this tournament a pleasure to run.




